CAFOD's Director of International Division, Geoff O'Donoghue, met the President of Niger last week to discuss the food crisis that is devastating West Africa? 5.5 million people are now at risk of severe food shortages and the worse is yet to come. Geoff said "We applaud the President for focusing early on the emergency food crisis. The international community needs to act now to prevent a humanitarian catastrophe. But it also needs to look at long-term investment to help Niger and its neighbours build resilience and end the devastating cycle of food crises."
