Did you know ..... there are 3 doctors to every 100,000 people in Niger? CAFOD's focus is in 4 main areas: *food security, prevention and fight against malnutrition, drought and flood, and capacity building.* Apart from chronic shortfalls of food, factors such as water shortages, poor water quality and sanitation conditions, inability to pay for medical services and poor child-care all contribute to rising malnutrition rates. The population is very vulnerable to disease - cholera, TB, meningitis. Malaria accounts for 50% of deaths among children under 5. With your support, CAFOD spent £134,453 in 2010/11 to help address this. Thank you.
