Did you know in Zimbabwe CAFOD's partner Caritas Masvingo works with smallholder farmers, training them in sustainable farming techniques? Jacob, 57, says: "When things were bad, we prayed. We were in crisis. Even if you found money, you needed to fill a satchel just to buy a small piece of bread. Caritas came, sat with us and spoke about better ways of farming." Jacob is now a trainer and teaches better farming techniques to his peers. "Caritas have stayed with us and have shown us love by training us to do more than survive.
